Prerequisites

Recommended prerequisites for successful completion of the program are:

- At least three years of PM&R residency. Fourth year PM&R residents may participate but should have their ACGME-required 20 toxin injections and 10 US scanning completed.
- Some familiarity with ultrasound and EMG principles.
- A sound working knowledge of MSK anatomy and kinesiology.
