PM&R: AN OVERVIEW OF THE FIELD









ABOUT PM&R PHYSICIANS

Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation physicians, also known as physiatrists, PM&R physicians, and more, treat a wide variety of medical conditions affecting the brain, spinal cord, nerves, bones, joints, ligaments, muscles and tendons. PM&R physicians evaluate and treat injuries, illnesses and disability, and are experts in designing comprehensive, patient-centered treatment plans. Physiatrists utilize cutting-edge as well as time-tested treatments to maximize function and quality-of-life.

- As a specialty, PM&R physicians are detectives, identifying root causes of disability, and removing barriers to living independently.
- PM&R physicians create custom recovery plans to help patients achieve specific goals (e.g., to be able to walk, to live alone, play a sport or return to work).
- By speeding recovery, PM&R physicians can reduce hospital length of stay, improve pain management, and partner with therapists to teach patients self-reliance, thus minimizing hospital readmissions.
- Early hospital consultation with PM&R physicians can reduce unnecessary procedures, guide post-acute care planning, enhance self-care skills, increase patient satisfaction, reduce polypharmacy and decrease the overall cost of care.
- Often work at the center of a larger care team.




THE AAPM&R ANNUAL ASSEMBLY EVENT EXPERIENCE

Each year, AAPM&R brings the PM&R community together at the Annual Assembly to advance the specialty. As the premier PM&R-focused event, our attendees connect, learn and expand their professional expertise. For 2024, we again hosted a hybrid meeting—in-person in San Diego as well as virtually for those who chose to participate remotely, ensuring accessibility and engagement for all attendees regardless of location. No matter which way attendees chose to participate, #AAPMR24 showcased *The Power of PM&R*—our event theme, which emphasized the strength of the specialty and the impact of our members in the house of medicine.

The 2024 Annual Assembly was jam-packed with the top-notch education, valuable networking opportunities and cutting-edge research that attendees have come to expect from the Academy. To ensure everyone has access to the exceptional content, all sessions, along with exhibitor descriptions, are available on the virtual platform until February 1, 2025. EDUCATION AT ITS BEST

The Academy is dedicated to serving as the primary resource for members, providing the highestquality and most relevant continuing education opportunities. From the experienced practitioner to those just starting their careers, the 2024 Annual Assembly offered unparalleled opportunities for professional growth and development. Attendees participated in 70+ educational session (40 of which were live-streamed, including the four plenaries). AAPM&R values the essential contributions of its exhibitors in making the event a success. Exhibitors with a badge had access to all educational sessions with the exception of Skills Labs, which required a ticket.

PRE-CONFERENCE COURSES

Attendees jump-started their Assembly experience with one of three pre-conference courses, which dove deep into ultrasound, concussion/mild TBI and electrodiagnostics (EDX)—common treatments and procedures that physiatrists perform.

ADVANCED CLINICAL FOCUS DAYS

Our attendees asked for more advanced content, and we answered with new Advanced Clinical Focus Days. During the Annual Assembly, we provided advanced, targeted full-day symposia in key clinical areas most relevant to attendees. THE AAPM&R MEMBERSHIP DATA COLLECTION PROCESS


Attendee and demographic data are accurate as of November 26, 2024.

ATTENDANCE BREAKDOWN




KEY INSIGHTS

- Most first-time attendees opted for in-person participation, indicating a preference for live engagement opportunities.








